This user guide is up to date as of 03.04.2021 and has been written based on Bludit v3.13.1.





## 1. Featured section

Featured section breaks the normal list of post entries. It is enabled by default and can be hidden from our plugin. Additionally, the header “Featured” can be replaced by any text.



To populate this section with posts, we use special category called “**special-featured**”. Just create one with this exact name and assign it when creating a post.



## 2. Setting up post entries on home page

By default, the featured section breaks the normal list of post entries. For example, let us have 5 standard posts:


- Post 1
- Post 2
- Post 3
- Post 4
- Post 5

By disabling featured section, then above is the way we will display posts.

When the featured section is enabled:

- Post 1
- Post 2
- Featured post 1
- Featured post 2
- Post 3
- Post 4
- Post 5

It is possible to change the number of posts displayed above featured break. This is the field in the plugin:




Number of posts to display above featured section

Enter a number. This specifies amount of posts to display above featured section. Go to General -> Advanced -> Items per page to control how many posts display in total on one page

By setting number “3”, the above example changes into:

- Post 1
- Post 2
- Post 3
- Featured post 1
- Featured post 2
- Post 4
- Post 5

It is possible to control the number of posts that are displayed below featured section. Just change “Items per page” from standard Bludit settings:


In posts, there are extra social buttons beside the main content.

## 4. Tags under the content of post

To provide SEO friendliness and extra theme options, it is possible to set tags through standard Bludit settings:



When writing new content, just set the tags:

## 5. Dark mode

The theme is bundled with a dark mode for anyone that prefers to use it. Go to our plugin and enable it by flicking the switch.

## 6. Extra tips

- Social section just above the footer can be turned into anything. We included option to override headings and specify custom HTML in the content.
  - For example: `<a href="https://google.com">@link text</a>`
- Bludit provides an option to set custom order of posts.
  - Go to Settings -> Advanced and set the field "**Order content by**" to Position
  - Then, when writing new content, just go to Options and set position numbers
